



## Client EIN/TIN Attestation

So that PPPs (Professional Payroll Processors) and their clients may transact on the ACH network, ACH rules and regulations require that Taxpayer Identification Numbers (TIN) or (EIN) be valid, and in good standing with the Federal Government.

Due to governing laws, NatPay is not allowed to verify PPP Client EIN/TIN numbers itself. Client EIN/TIN numbers must be verified by the PPP via the IRS.
